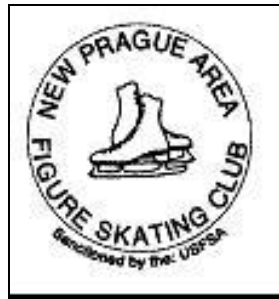

We are proud and fortunate to have several very accomplished, qualified coaches to help build the skills of our skaters.



Our club services the needs of both the recreational and competitive skaters from child-adult. We host USFSA testing sessions and many of our skaters participate in competitions throughout the regions.

The US Figure Skating Basic Skills Program is taught in private and group lessons. The curriculum is designed to keep skaters enthusiastic about learning from the time they begin lessons through reaching their goals.



Membership Benefits

- Our club season at the New Prague Area Community Center runs from Sep-March. During those months our skaters usually skate 2-3 times per week.

- We are unique in that members are invited to skate in our skater exhibitions as part of their club membership. Members may skate in a feature number as well choreographed group numbers.

- Members have the opportunity to participate in a variety of specialized classes and skating clinics throughout the year.

- Club members also enjoy getting together off the ice for club outings to other skating events and special club get togethers.
